



































PARACHUTE COMPANY

The British Rifle Platoon represents the platoons of the 4th Dorsets (43rd Wessex Division), that attempted to cross the Lower Rhine during the early morning hours of September 25th.

The Polish Parachute platoon represents a platoon sized force lead by Lt. Albert Smaczny from the 8th Company that was successfully ferried across the Lower Rhine. During the evening of September 24th about 100 Polish Paras from the 3rd Battalion and the Anti-Tank Company were successfully ferried across the river. Polish Parachute Platoons and Polish Anti-Tank Batteries are considered Allied Platoons as described on page 183 of the rulebook.
